\$10 per class - *Ribbons to 6th place*. Unlimited entries for \$50 if a member of the Riding Club. Riding Club Membership \$17. Clear Round entries \$5 each.

## Morning Classes - 9am start

1. **Best Turned Out (Ridden)** ~ Judged on cleanliness and presentation of horse, rider, and tack, and efforts made by rider. Open to English and Western attire. Lead-line riders welcome.
2. **Lead-line** ~ Judged on suitability of horse/pony and ability of rider. Open to English and Western attire.
3. **Condition in Hand** ~ Judged on overall condition and performance of horse. Open to English and Western horses.
4. **Pretty Pony/Handsome Horse** ~ Shown in hand. The cutest pony/horse. Ribbons to all entries.
5. **Ridden Veteran** ~ Horse/pony 15 years and older, judged on health and performance. Open to English and Western riders.
6. **Beginners Equitation** ~ Rider must never have been placed in an equitation class, judged on rider's ability. Open to English and Western riders. Walk only.
7. **Novice Equitation** ~ Rider must never have won an equitation class, judged on rider's ability. Open to English and Western riders. Walk, trot.
8. **Open Equitation** ~ Judged on rider's ability. Open to English and Western Riders. Walk, trot, canter.
9. **Ridden Pleasure** ~ Judged on manners, control, suitability, and soundness of horse. Open to English and Western horses.
10. **Handy Pony** ~ against the clock around an obstacle course.

## Afternoon Classes - will not start before noon

### Hunter Classes

11. **1' Clear Round** ~ Jump clear and get a rosette.
12. **Pre-Short Stirrup Over Fences** ~ Horse and rider must never have been placed in a hunter jumper class. Judged on performance and suitability. Max height 1'.
13. **18" Clear Round** ~ Jump clear and get a rosette.
14. **Short Stirrup Over Fences** ~ Horse and rider must never have won a hunter jumper class. Max height 18". Judged on performance and suitability.
15. **2' Clear Round** ~ Jump clear and get a rosette.
16. **Low Hunter** ~ Horse and rider must never have won a hunter jumper class up to 2'. Judged on performance and suitability.
17. **2' 3" Clear Round** ~ Jump clear and get a rosette.
18. **Open Hunter** ~ Judged on performance and suitability. Max height 2' 3"

### Jumper Classes

19. **Absolute Beginners Jumping** ~ Horse and rider must never have been placed in any jumping class. Max height 1'
18. **Beginners Jumping** ~ Horse and rider must never have won a jumping class. Max height 18"
21. **Novice Jumping** ~ Horse and rider must never have won a novice jumping class. Max height 2'
24. **Open Jumping** ~ Max height 2' 3" first round

# Show Rules

1. All riders must wear a properly fitted ASTM/SEI helmet at all times while mounted.
2. All competitors must sign (or have a parent/guardian sign for a minor) an equine activities waiver.
3. Your presence at the show indicates that you have read these rules and agree to abide by them.
4. The organizers, management, staff, volunteers, helpers, White Rose Equestrian, will not be held responsible or liable for any loss, damage, accident, or injury caused to any person, property, or livestock while attending the show.
5. Competitors and spectators take part at their own risk.
6. The judges decision in each class is final.
7. Horses/ponies may enter, more than once in any class except 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 9.
8. The organizers reserve the right to refuse entries considered to be unsuitable for any class or to expel from the showground any person or horse/pony behaving in a manner likely to adversely effect the safety and enjoyment of others.
9. Cruelty and/or excessive use of crop or spurs will not be tolerated.
10. All classes will be placed to 6th place except classes 4, 11, 13, 15, and 17.
11. If you borrow a horse from the barn you must book and pay for your classes at least one week in advance of the show date.
12. Dogs must be kept under strict control and on a leash at all times.
13. No cantering on the showground except in designated areas. Absolutely no galloping on the showground.
14. Class eligibility remains until the end of the show season.
