Rosettes to 6<sup>th</sup> place.

1. **Best Turned Out (Ridden)** ~ Judged on cleanliness and presentation of horse, rider, and tack, and efforts made by rider. Open to English and Western attire. Lead-line riders welcome.
2. **Lead-line** ~ Judged on suitability of horse/pony and ability of rider. Open to English and Western attire.
3. **Condition in Hand** ~ Judged on overall condition and performance of horse. Open to English and Western horses.
4. **Pretty Pony/Handsome Horse** ~ Shown in-hand. Ribbons to all entries.
5. **In-hand Trail Class** ~ Shown in-hand around an obstacle course. Judge on manners and performance of horse and ability of handler.
6. **Handy Pony** ~ Ridden class, against the clock around an obstacle course
7. **Ridden Veteran** ~ Horse/pony 15 years and older, judged on health and performance. Open to English and Western riders.
8. **Beginners Equitation** ~ Rider must never have been placed in an equitation class, judged on rider's ability. Walk only.
9. **Novice English Equitation** ~ Rider must never have won an equitation class, judged on rider's ability. Walk, trot.
10. **Open English Equitation** ~ Judged on rider's ability. Walk, trot, canter.
11. **Ridden Pleasure** ~ Judged on manners, control, suitability, and soundness of horse.
12. **Beginners Hunt Seat Jumping** ~ Horse and rider must never have been placed in any hunter class. Max height 6"
13. **Beginners Jumping** ~ Horse and rider must never have been placed in a jumping class. Max height 6"

# Show Rules

1. All riders must wear a properly fitted ASTM/SEI helmet at all times while mounted.
2. All competitors must sign (or have a parent/guardian sign for a minor) an equine activities waiver.
3. Your presence at the show indicates that you have read these rules and agree to abide by them.
4. The organizers, management, staff, volunteers, helpers, judges, White Rose Equestrian, will not be held responsible or liable for any loss, damage, accident, or injury caused to any person, property, or livestock while attending the show.
5. Competitors and spectators take part at their own risk.
6. The judges decision in each class is final.
7. Horses/ponies may enter, more than once in any class except 1, 2, 3, 4, 7, 11.
8. The organizers reserve the right to refuse entries considered to be unsuitable for any class or to expel from the showground any person or horse/pony behaving in a manner likely to adversely effect the safety and enjoyment of others.
9. Cruelty and/or excessive use of crop or spurs will not be tolerated.
10. All classes will be placed to 6th place except class 4.
11. If you borrow a horse from the barn you must book and pay for your classes at least one week in advance of the show date.
12. Dogs must be kept under strict control and on a leash at all times.
13. No cantering on the showground except in designated areas. Absolutely no galloping on the showground.
