Rosettes to 6th place.

1. **Best Turned Out (Ridden)** ~ Judged on cleanliness and presentation of horse, rider, and tack, and the rider's efforts. Open to English and Western attire. Lead-line riders are welcome. Not judged on riding ability.
2. **Lead-line** ~ Judged on the suitability of horse/pony to look after a young rider. Open to English and Western attire.
3. **Condition in Hand** ~ Judged on overall condition and performance of the horse.
4. **Pretty Pony/Handsome Horse** ~ Shown in-hand. Ribbons to all entries.
5. **In-hand Trail Class** ~ Shown in-hand around an obstacle course. Judged on manners and performance of horse and ability of handler.
6. **Handy Pony** ~ Ridden class, against the clock around an obstacle course.
7. **Ridden Veteran** ~ Horse/pony 15 years and older, judged on health and performance. Open to English and Western riders.
8. **Beginners Equitation** ~ Rider must never have been placed in an equitation class, judged on rider's ability. Walk only. Open to English and Western riders.
9. **Novice English Equitation** ~ Rider must never have won an equitation class, judged on rider's ability. Walk, trot. Open to English and Western Riders.
10. **Open English Equitation** ~ Judged on rider's ability. Walk, trot, canter. Open to English and Western riders.
11. **Ridden Pleasure** ~ Judged on manners, control, suitability, and soundness of the horse.
12. **Steady Eddy** ~ Walk and trot carrying a cup of water. The rider with the most water left is the winner.
13. **Musical Blocks** ~ Like musical chairs, but instead, you take your horse to a block when the music stops.
14. **Ride a Buck** ~ Ride bareback with a dollar bill under your thigh. The one who still has the buck left is the winner.

Show Rules

1. All riders must wear a properly fitted ASTM/SEI helmet at all times while mounted.
2. All competitors must sign (or have a parent/guardian sign for a minor) an equine activities waiver.
3. Your presence at the show indicates that you have read these rules and agree to abide by them.
4. The organizers, management, staff, volunteers, helpers, judges, White Rose Equestrian will not be held responsible or liable for any loss, damage, accident, or injury caused to any person, property, or livestock while attending the show.
5. Competitors and spectators take part at their own risk.
6. The judge's decision in each class is final.
7. Horses/ponies may enter more than once in any class except 1, 2, 3, 4, 7, 11, 12, 13, 14.
8. The organizers reserve the right to refuse entries considered unsuitable for any class or to expel from the showground any person or horse/pony behaving in a manner likely to adversely affect others' safety and enjoyment.
9. Cruelty and/or excessive use of crop or spurs will not be tolerated.
10. All classes will be placed to 6th place except class 4.
11. If you borrow a horse from the barn, you must book and pay for your classes at least one week before the show date.
12. Dogs must be kept under strict control and on a leash at all times.
13. No cantering on the showground except in designated areas. Absolutely no galloping on the showground.

The organizers will do their utmost to ensure that everyone has an enjoyable and safe show day, but we need your co-operation to achieve this. Please read these rules carefully. Thank you.
